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SYWO Parent Code of Conduct

- I will not force my child to participate in sports.
- I will remember that children participate to have fun and that the game is for the youth, not adults.
- I will inform the coach of any physical disability or ailment that may affect the safety of my child or the safety of others.
- I will learn the rules of the game and the policies of the league.
- I (and my guests) will be a positive role model for my child and encourage sportsmanship by showing respect and courtesy, and by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, officials and spectators at every game, practice or other sporting event.
- I (and my guests) will not engage in any kind of unsportsmanlike conduct with any official, coach, player, or parent such as booing and taunting; refusing to shake hands; or using profane language or gestures.
- I will not encourage any behaviors or practices that would endanger the health and well being of the athletes.
- I will teach my child to play by the rules and to resolve conflicts without resorting to hostility or violence.
- I will demand that my child treat other players, coaches, officials and spectators with respect regardless of race, creed, color, sex or ability.
- I will teach my child that doing one's best is more important than winning.
- I will praise my child for competing fairly and trying hard.
- I will never ridicule or yell at my child or other participant for making a mistake or losing a competition.
- I will emphasize skill development and practices and how they benefit my child over winning.
- I will promote the emotional and physical well being of the athletes ahead of any personal desire I may have for my child to win.
- I will respect the officials and their authority during games and will never question, discuss, or confront coaches at a tournament, and will take time to speak with coaches at an agreed upon time and place.
- I will demand a sports environment for my child that is free from drugs, tobacco, and alcohol and I will refrain from their use at all sports events.
- I will refrain from coaching my child or other players during games and practices, unless I am one of the official coaches of the team.
- Absolutely no weapons allowed at any SYWO event.
- I agree that if I fail to abide by the aforementioned rules and guidelines, I will be subject to disciplinary action deemed necessary by the Discipline Review Committee that could include, but is not limited to the following:
 - o Verbal warning
 - o Written warning
 - o Parental tournament suspension with written documentation of incident kept on file by the SYWO
 - o Match/tournament forfeit through the official or coach
 - o Parental season suspension



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SYWO Wrestler Code of Conduct

- Wrestle for FUN. Enjoy yourself. Be proud of being a wrestler.
- WORK HARD to improve your skills. Listen, ask questions, and watch others to see how you can better your skills.
- Be a TEAM PLAYER – get along with your teammates. Appreciate the contribution each person makes to the team.
- Learn TEAMWORK, SPORTSMANSHIP, and DISCIPLINE.
- Be on time for practices and tournaments, and be both mentally and physically prepared at the start of each practice and tournament.
- Learn the rules, and follow them. Always be a GOOD SPORT and set a positive example for others, particularly younger wrestlers.
- RESPECT your coach, your teammates, your parents, opponents and officials. Never do anything that in any way makes another person feel badly about themselves.
- Never argue with the official's decision.
- Learn to lose with dignity and to win with grace.
- Keep the sports environment free from drugs, tobacco, and alcohol.
- Absolutely no weapons allowed at any SYWO event.
